A that time, the building generated some controversy, but today it is considered to be a prime example of modern Dutch architecture.

Speakers are requested to upload their slides in PDF or PPT format by June  $2^{nd}$ . The usage of personal laptops for presentations will not be permitted. The talks should be uploaded via the <u>indico agenda page</u>. The posters can be displayed from the first day of the conference and have to be taken down before the closing session on the last day.

## **Proceedings**

Conference proceedings will be published in <u>Proceedings of Science</u>, the open access online journal organized by SISSA. The number of pages allocated for the proceedings are the following: 10 pages for plenary talks, 8 pages for parallel talks, and 4 pages for posters.
